General Conditions for all work:

1. All work within the County Road Right of Way is required to be permitted by the County Engineer.
2. The Highway Department shall be notified not less than two business days before commencing any work within a County Road Right of Way.
3. Traffic shall be protected and the work zone shall be maintained and operated in safe manner at all times.
4. The road surface, shoulders, culverts, pipes and other structures shall be restored to its original condition and satisfaction of the County Engineer by the permittee.
5. All brush and tree trimmings shall be removed from the road right of way.
6. Bridge load limits shall be observed and conformed to as specified at given bridges.
7. Further, the County will not be responsible or liable for property damage and said Company shall indemnify and save harmless said County of Guernsey from any and all claims, demands, actions, or causes of action from said damages to persons or property arising from permission herein granted.
8. All utility companies must be properly notified of any construction by calling 1-800-362-2764 or 811.
9. Failure to comply with the conditions set forth shall be grounds for permit revocation.

The following conditions shall be met for the design and installation of infrastructure and utilities along County Roads.

1. Utility owner must be a member of OUPS and respond to locate requests.
2. The design plans will be drawn to scale and accurately depict existing conditions, utilities, infrastructure, topography, pavement location, and RW width.
3. New pole locations shall be placed outside of the ditch line and a minimum of 10' from the edge of pavement, unless otherwise required per ODOT design requirements.
4. Aerial crossings shall provide a minimum of 16.5' clearance through the right of way.
5. New or relocated pole locations shall be field staked prior to final approval.
6. Alignment must be a minimum of 10 feet away from the edge of pavement.
7. A minimum 4-foot horizontal separation from water, sewer, and gas utilities are required.
8. A 10-foot horizontal separation from bridge abutments and culverts shall be maintained.
9. No bore pits are permitted within 8 feet of the edge of pavement.
10. No open cuts across a county road shall be allowed.
11. No open cuts across a paved private drive or township road shall be allowed.
12. Typical depths and utility crossings shall be shown for all bores.
13. Any existing utilities shall be potholed prior to crossing.

Construction/contractor requirements prior to work commencement:

1. All construction must be completed in compliance with the design standards.

- 2. All contractors name and contact information shall be provided to the County Engineer.
- 3. Traffic must be maintained and all requirements of Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and ODOT Item 614.
- 4. Debris from clearing shall be disposed of offsite and completed at the owner's expense.
- 5. Equipment and vehicles shall not occupy the road unless within a work zone enclosure.
- 6. The road will be kept free of construction debris, dirt and gravel.
- 7. Any traffic control or closure must be coordinated with the Guernsey County Engineer.
- 8. A final record set of as-built plans shall be provided to the County, at the cost of the permittee, contractor, or owner.
